Thread	Black 06 08
Rear body	White cock feather
Front Body	Black cock feather





1. Tie-in the thread up to the middle of the hook shank



3. Wind the thread to the curvature of the hook



2. Tie-in the white cock feather concave side up as shown in the picture



4. Wind the feather to the curvature of the hook



- Tie-off the feather at the curvature of the hook
- 6. Wind thread through the palmered feather making sure not to catch any feather tips



- 9. Wind the feather in tight turns back to the beginning of the white palmer
- 10. Tie-off the feather with the thread
- 11. Wind thread through the palmered feather making sure not to catch any feather tips

- 14. Varnish head with black or transparent head cement



- 7. Tie-in the black cock feather at the eye of the kook in a similar way than the white feather but this time concave side facing down
- 8. Wind the thread to the beginning of the white feather
