


Bommel

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 10 12 14
Thread:	Black 08
Wing:	CDC white
Body:	CDC black/yellow
Thorax:	CDC black



- 1 Tie in the thread at the curvature of the hook



- 2 Make a dubbing loop
- 3 Wind thread to the eye of the hook
- 4 Insert a bunch of black and yellow CDC feather tips in the loop
- 5 Twist



- 6 Wind the loop in direction of the eye of the hook
- 7 Compact the body by pushing it backwards with a small tube



- 8 Repeat steps 2 to 7



- 9 Make a dubbing loop
- 10 Wind thread to the eye of the hook
- 11 Insert a bunch of black CDC feather tips in the loop
- 12 Twist
- 13 Wind last segment of the body



- 14 Trim the body with your scissors



- 15 Flip back the feather tips of a white CDC feather and tie in the feather as shown on the picture



- 16 Pull the first free feather tip along the stem of the feather to form the wings
- 17 Cut off the stem



- 18 Insert a bunch of short black CDC feather tips in the split thread
- 19 Twist
- 20 Wind thorax



- 21 Wind the head of the fly
- 22 Whipfinish
- 23 Apply a drop of varnish to the head
