Materials:

Hook:	Partridge double silver 7-11
Thread:	Black 08
Tag:	Twisted silver wire
Tail:	
Body:	Silver tinsel flat
Ribbing:	Twisted silver wire
Cheeks:	
Wing:	Peacock herl over
	Templedog black over
	Bucktail white






1. Tie-in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns in direction of the curvature of the hook



2. Tie-in the twisted silver wire




- 3. Wind a tag for 4-5 turns
- 4. Bring back the wire between the 2 hooks on the underside of the hook shank
- 5. Tie off the wire



- 6. Bend the wire in direction of the curvature of the hook
- 7. Wind the thread in direction of the eye of the hook
- 8. Tie-in the silver tinsel



Wind the body by winding the tinsel backwards to the tag and then back to the eye of the hook





13. Tie-in the bucktail as shown. The length is approximately double shank length




15. Tie-in the Templedog wing (should be slightly longer than the bucktail wing



17. Wind the head 18. Whipfinish



11. Wind the ribbing in direction of the ey of the hook





14. Flip back the bucktail wing and secure it wit a few windings



16. Tie in 2-3 Peacock herls over the Templedog wing



19. Add a drop of black head cement to secure the windings
