Copper Wire Pheasant Tail

Materials:

Hook:	Kamasan B402 12-20 TMC 100BL 12-20
Thread:	Fine copper wire
Tail&Body:	Pheasant tail fiber tips





- 1 Tie in the copper wire at the eye of the hook
- 2 Wind it in close turns down to the curvature of the hook



Tie in the Pheasant tail fiber tips as a tail



4 Adjust the length of the tail



5 Wind the copper wire to the eye of the hook



6 Wind the heasant tail fiber tips to the eye of the hook7 Tie off the Fiber tips



Wind the thorax with the copper wire





Flip the pheasant tail fiber tips over the thorax to the eye of the hook

10 Secure the pheasant tail fiber tips with 1 or 2 turns of wire



13 Cut off the excess of fiber tips

14 Apply a drop of instant glue on the copper wire



11 Flip the pheasant tail fiber tips backwards in direction of the curvature of the hook

12 Tie off the pheasant tail fiber tips



15 Wind 3-4 turns of copper wire to form the head

- 16 Wait for the instant glue to dry
- 17 Break the copper wire by moving it back and forth
