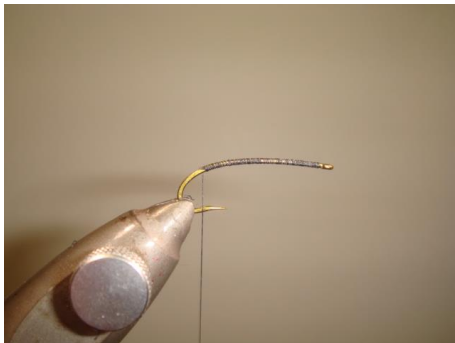


Parachute

Hook	TMC200R 10-16 Kamasan B220 10-16
Thread	Black 08
Rear Body	Moose hair yellow & olive
Parachute post	Glow yarn or Antron yarn
Parachute	Grizzly cock hackle
Thorax	Fine black dubbing



1. Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
2. Wind it in close turns into the curvature of the hook



3. Tie in the Moose hair
4. Wind thread back



5. Wind the 2 Moose hair together in direction of the eye of the hook



6. Tie in the glow yarn as a parachute post
7. Clamp it in the gallows



8. Tie in the cock feather
9. Wind Thread to the eye of the hook



10. Wind the head of the fly



11. Twist some black dubbing on the thread and wind the thorax of the fly
12. Make sure to finish this step with the thread resting behind (on the hook side) of the parachute post



13. Wind the parachute. Make sure that each new turn is under the previous one
14. If not yet done, clamp the feather in a hackle clamp and let it hang on the side of the shank facing towards you.



15. Wind 2 turns of thread around the parachute post just above the hook shank beneath the parachute
16. Cut off the feather



17. Turn the vise
18. Whipfinish under the parachute above the hook shank



19. You haven't trapped any parachute feather tips at the eye of the hook or under the hook shank
