Wooden Emerger


Materials:

Hook:	TMC2487 10-12
	Kamasan B100 10-12
Thread:	Black 8/0
Head:	Wood bead 4mm
Antennas:	Yellow foam
Body:	Unistretch olive
Ribbing:	Copper wire fine
Plus:	UV glue





Thread the wooden bead on the hook 1



- Bias cut a foam strip of about 2-4 3mm
- 5 Tie in the tip of the foam strip, the rest of the strip pointing to the right



9 Slide the bead over the tie off point of the foam strip





10 Tie in the Unistretch behind the bead head





Tie in the thread and wind a it in 2 close turns for about 1cm 3 Wind the thread back to the eye



- Flip the strip backwards to the 6 hook curvature
- Cut or tear off the excess



- 11 Tie in the copper wire
- 12 Secure the copper wire deep into the curvature of the hook



- 14 Wind the ribbing wire forward to the bead head
- 15 Secure the wire with 2-3 turns of Unistretch



13 Wind a tapered body with the Unistretch



16 Whipfinish behind the bead head



17 Incise the Foam strip



- 18 Trim the foam strip
- 19 Cover the body with a layer of UV glue $% \left({{\left[{{{\left[{{{\left[{{{c_{{\rm{w}}}}} \right]}}} \right]}_{\rm{s}}}}} \right)$
- $20\,$ Cure the glue using an UV torch
