## Hotspot Pheasant Tail

## Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 12-18
	Kamasan B400 12-18
Thread:	Black 8/0
Beads:	Brass 3mm-1.5mm
Hotspot:	Unistretch orange
Tail:	Pheasant tail fibers
Body & Thorax:	Pheasant tail fibers
Plus	UV glue
	Instant glue





Insert 2 brass beads on the hook, the conical boreholes facing each



Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook

- Wind head
- Whipfinish



Tie in the thread behind the second bead



between the beads

Fill the gap and whipfinish



Apply some UV glue on the Thorax and cure it with the UV torch



10 Tie in some 10 pheasant tail fibers as a tail





Wind the bunch of fibers forwards to the rear bead

- 12 Tie them off above the hook shank
- 13 Whipfinish and cut off the thread



Flip the pheasant tail fibers over the thorax to the eye of the hook

16 Secure them with a couple of windings



18 Apply a drop of instant glue on the thread



Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook 14



17 Cut off the excess of fibers



19 Wind the final head 20 Cut off the thread
