Irresistible Wulff

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 10-12
	Kamasan B400 10-12
Thread:	Black 8/0
Tail:	Buck tail black
Body:	Deer hair
Wing:	Buck tail white
Hackle:	Badger brown cock feather





1 Tie in the thread at curvature of the hook



Tie in a bunch of black buck tail as a tail



3 Form a dubbing loop

4 Insert a bunch of deer hair into the loop and twist the loop



With this dubbing strand, wind the body of the fly



6 If there is not enough material, form a new dubbing loop and repeat step 5



7 Whipfinish and cut of the thread



8 Shape the body roughly with the scissors



11 Tie in The thread at the eye of the hook

12 Tie in a bunch of white buck tail





9 Slide a piece of drinking straw over the tail.

10 Singe the body using a lighter to seal the hair tips



13 Separate the buck tail tips into 2 identical portions and form 2 wings by winding figure 8 turns of tying thread



15 Wind the 3 turns of hackle behind and 3 turns in front of the wings

- 16 Wind the head of the fly
- 17 Whipfinish
