Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns to the beginning of curvature of the hook



? Tie in the ribbing wire



- 3 Make a Dubbing loop
- $\begin{array}{lll} 4 & \hbox{Wind the tying thread to the eye} \\ & \hbox{of the hook} \end{array}$



- 5 Insert a bunch of black seals fur in the dubbing loop followed by a bunch of red and another bunch of black seals fur.
- 6 Secure the seals fur by twisting the loop.
- 7 Wind the body of the fly





- 8 Tie in a small black cock feather at the eye of the hook
- 9 Wind the feather to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



12 Tie in 2 pairs of legs on each side of the hook shank.



14 Wind the head hackle



17 Whipfinish



- 10 Secure the feather with the ribbing wire
- 11 Wind the wire to the eye of the hook and tie it off



13 Tie in a larger cock featherat the eye of the hook



15 Tie off the hackle 16 Wind the head of the fly



 $18\,$ Add a drop of black head cement or UV glue on the head of the fly
