



Jassid

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 or Kamasan B400 #12-16
Thread:	Black 8/0
Body:	Black cock feather palmered
Wing:	Jungle cock feather tips
Hackle:	Black cock feather



- 1 Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook
- 2 Wind it in close turns to the beginning of the curvature of the hook
- 3 Wind the thread back in direction of the eye of the hook



- 4 Tie in a larger cock feather



- 5 Wind it in close turns to the beginning of the curvature of the hook
- 6 Then wind it back in direction of the eye of the hook



- 7 Cut off the feather tips above and below the hook shank
- 8 Tie in the nail on top of the hook shank



9 Tie in a jungle cock feather on top of the hook shank



10 Tie in a smaller cock feather behind the eye of the hook

11 Secure the quill by winding the thread in direction of the tie in point of the wing



12 Wind the hackle feather in direction of the tie in point of the wing

13 Wind the thread through the hackle to the eye of the hook



14 Wind the head of the fly



15 Whipfinish

16 Apply a drop of head cement to the head
