Purple Snaelda Tubefly

Materials:

Tube:	XS black plastic 2.5cm
Thread:	Black 8/0
Tail:	Purple bucktail
Ribbing:	Twisted silver wire
Body:	Purple wool or chenille
Front Hackle:	purple badger cock





- Using a lighter, melt both ends of the tube
- Insert the tube into a silicon tubing



- Fix the tube on the needle of your vice.
- Tie in the thread at the rear end of the tube and secure the silicon tube



Tie in a bunch of purple bucktail and spread it around the upper part of the



bucktail and spread it around the lower part of the tube



Cut off the excess of bucktail as shown in the image




8 Secure the ends of the bucktail with your tying thread, creating a slightly tapered body





Tie in the twisted silver wire close to the tail of the fly




10 Remove some chenille from the core at one end of the chenille



11 Tie in the core of the chenille 12 Wind the Thread to the head of the fly



13 Wind the body of the fly with the chenille



15 Tie in the cock feather by its tip


14 Wind the ribbing to the front of the fly



16 Wind 3-4 turns of head hackle



17 Wind the head of the fly





19 Apply a drop of UV Glue on the head 20 Cure it with the UV torch
