Woven Wire Nymph

Materials:

Hook:	TMC100 or Kamasan B400 #10-18
Thread:	Black 8/0
Tail:	Jungle Cock
Body	Black and red wire 0.18mm
Front body:	Purple Floss
Wingcase:	Red or Orange Latex strip
Thorax:	Grey Hare dubbing





Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



Tie in a bunch of Jungle cock feather tips as a tail



Tie in a black wire and a red wire.

Secure both wires on the sides of the hook shank to the tie in point of the tail. The red wire will be facing to you and the black one will be on the other side of the hook shank.



- 5 Wind a tapered body with your tying thread
- 6 Whipfinish
- 7 Cut off the tying thread



Bring the black wire from the rear side to the front side of the hook

- Pass the red wire over the black one and bring it the to the rear side $\,$ passing under the hook shank
- 10 Flip the black wire to the rear side of the hook shank.
- 11 Pass the red wire over the black one and bring it back to the side of the $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$ hook shank facing to you by passing it under the hook shank



Repeat steps 8 to 11 until you have completed the weaving of the body



13 Tie in a strip of orange or red latex



14 Twist the grey dubbing onto your tying thread and wind the thorax of the fly



15 Flip the latex over the thorax to the eye of the hook

- 16 Tie it off 17 Wind the head of the fly



18 Whipfinish and cut off the thread
