

Red Tag

Hook	TMC100 #10-18 Kamasan B400 #10-18
Thread	Black 8/0
Tail	Red wool
Body	Peacock herl
Hackle	Black hen feather



1. Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns over the beginning of the curvature of the hook
2. Then wind it back in direction of the eye of the hook



3. Tie-in the red wool and secure it over the length of the hook shank.
4. Cut the wool to create a short tail.



5. Tie in 2 peacock herls.
6. Secure the herls back to the beginning of the tail.



7. Lay the peacock herls around the hook shank
8. Form a dubbing loop with your thread
9. Wind the thread in direction of the eye of the hook
10. Twist both peacock herls and the dubbing loop together to create a strong strand.



11. Wind the Peacock strand in direction of the eye of the hook
12. Tie it off
13. Cut-off the excess



14. Tie in the black hen feather by its tip



15. Wind the wet hackle (3-4 turns)
16. Wind the head of the fly
17. Whip finish
18. Cut off tying thread



19. Apply a drop of transparent head cement onto the head
