Hook	TMC100 #10-14
	Kamasan B400 #10-14
Thread	Black 8/0
Tail	Blue cock feather
Body	Blue and black cock feather
	palmered
Ribbing	Silver wire





1. Tie in the thread at the eye of the hook and wind it in close turns to the middle of the hook shank



3. Cut the cock feathers to shorten the tail



6. Tie in a blue and a black cock feather at the eye of the hook



2. Tie in blue cock feather tips and secure them to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



- 4. Tie in the silver wire
- 5. Wind thread to the eye of the hook



7. Double both feathers together





8. Wind both feathers together to the beginning of the curvature of the hook



11. Wind the head of the fly 12. Whipfinish



9. Secure the feathers with the ribbing wire

10. Wind the ribbing wire to the eye of the hook



13. Apply a drop of black head cement onto the head of the fly (or a drop of UV glue and cure it with your UV torch)
